## ABOUT THE SESSION:

This course will provide information on pharmaceuticals, and pharmaceutical issues, for speech pathologists and audiologists in clinical practice. It is designed to acquaint the participant with fundamental information for enhancing the understanding of how commonly prescribed drugs, and over-the-counter (OTC) preparations impact the physiology and behavior of the patients we may serve. Historical perspectives on pharmaceutical development, control, and regulation will be cited. Specific pharmaceuticals will be referenced by intended site of impact. Terminology will be reviewed, and resources recommended. Audience participation is valued, and questions and comments are encouraged.
